This forum must be mindful about it's critical thought and advocacy. We have here (in the BOU) a space of wonderful possibility, a space established for quality reasoning (**sababu**), intended for **the development of clarity and progress**.

Personally I find the rise of **anti-Chinese rhetoric** from some vocal Africans a tragic turn. A poor use of time and energy at a time when we need to focus on the key points of development potential. What can be done to balance the relationship (ratios) of power between the cultural dynamics of Africa and China?. Establishing sovereign peership and mutually respectful cooperation should be our focus point, surely?

It is easy to join the anti-Chinese rhetoric bandwagon, I caution against it, it is anti-maat; anti-justice, anti-humanity-overstood. Are Ones anti-Chinese people, anti-Chinese government or both? ! Metaphysically self-destructive; a critically poor use of time and energy.

I am very clear that "China" can do and does do White racism as well as Europe, the USA and other dominating cultures – institutionalised power injustices, imbalances, inequalities against progressively more melanated beings and cultures; fear of a Black planet is a global phenomena, a "loveHATE" **V** psychosis and insecurity. Let us not jump from one "master's" dog-whistle to attack another "master". Our objective is to **dismantle THE WHOLE structure of injustice**, establishing and maintaining as we go, the proper human social order (Maat) - **Sovereign Peership** - this is not the domination model. The **Black Open University** as an organization for advancing education from an African place of being is a key place to discuss developing answers (and more questions) towards these kinds of objective.
